Living Areas



- Paneling, Pressed-Wood Furniture and Cabinetry**
May release formaldehyde gas.



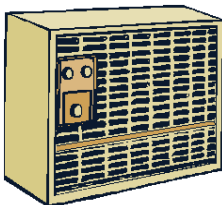
- Carpets**
Biological pollutants can grow on water-damaged carpet; organic gases from new carpet.



- Floor Tiles**
Some contain asbestos.



- House Dust Mites**
Biological allergens can trigger asthma.



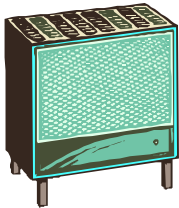
- Air Conditioner**
Biological allergens.



- Fireplaces**
Carbon monoxide and combustion pollutants.



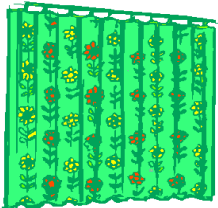
- Moisture**
Encourages the growth of mold and mildew, as well as dust mites and cockroaches.



- Gas or Kerosene Space Heater**
Carbon monoxide and combustion pollutants.



- Secondhand Smoke Environmental Tobacco Smoke)**
Contains harmful combustion and particulate pollutants including carbon monoxide and combustion by-products.



- Draperies**
May be treated with a formaldehyde-based finish and emit odors for a short period of time.



- Lead-Based Paint**
Paint manufactured before 1978 can contain lead.



- Animals**
Leave allergens such as dander, hair, feathers and skin in the air.
